# How we can help...

The Town's Economic Development Department facilitates the community's economic growth by working with employers of all sizes and other economic development partners to bring jobs, residents, and visitors to Groton.



## AIRPORT DEVELOPMENT ZONE/ ENTERPRISE ZONE

Five-year, 80% abatement of real and personal property taxes and credits on state corporation business taxes for improvements that increase the property's value. Eligible investments include new construction as well as renovation and expansion. Available to manufacturers, technology and warehousing.



## ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE FUND

Financial support for public infrastructure associated with new development projects:

- Utility line extensions
- Sidewalks/ streetscapes
- Road improvements
- Traffic control/street lighting



## SMALL BUSINESS EXPRESS PROGRAM

Loans and grants to Connecticut's small businesses to spur job creation and growth.



## ZONING REGULATIONS REVISIONS

Groton is currently amending their zoning regulations to make them more user-friendly for businesses and property owners, including clarifying and consolidating permitted-use categories and simplifying the approval process.
